"When I first got here, as I said, I was one of a handful of Puerto Rican or Hispanic police officers and it wasn't easy."

CRUZ HAS BEEN A POLICE OFFICER WITH THE CICERO POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR 23 YEARS. HE JOINED THE FORCE AFTER NOTICING AS A CHILD HOW FEW CPD OFFICERS LOOKED LIKE HIM.

"It took time for them to trust. It took time for them to understand where I came from. I fought hard to get through teaching people to avoid this type of situation and moved up the chain of command ... and to be a role model for Puerto Rican and Hispanic officers."

CRUZ WAS ABLE TO BECOME A ROLE MODEL FOR HIS COMMUNITY THROUGH HIS INVOLVEMENT WITH THE PUERTO RICAN POLICE ASSOCIATION.

"This is the only Puerto Rican Police Association in the country. So we have expanded from being one of the smallest Hispanic organizations in the state to being the largest now."

ONE OF THE ORGANIZATION'S 200 MEMBERS SAID HE WAS ATTRACTED TO PRPA BECAUSE OF ITS CONNECTION TO THE COMMUNITY.
